

My Daddy Don't Go To Work (1978) by Madeena Nolan – A story about a family troubled by the father's unemployment.

My Father's Boat (1998) by Sherry Garland – A Vietnamese immigrant tells his son how he learned to fish from his father.

My Mother's House, My Father's House (1990) by C. B. Christiansen – A story about a child who lives part of the week with her mother and the rest of the week with her father.

Night Driving (1996) by John Coy – A father and son drive in the night and watch for night animals, swap baseball stories, and keep a lookout for eighteen wheelers.

Owl Moon (1987) by Jane Yolen – On a winter's night under a full moon, a father and daughter trek in to the woods to go owling.

Papa's Stories (1994) by Dolores Johnson – A little girl enjoys her father reading stories to her, but then discovers he's telling stories because he can't read.

Reading With Dad (2000) by Richard Jorgenson – The poetic story of a father and daughter sharing a lifetime love of books and reading.

Sammy Wakes His Dad (2002) by Chip Emmons – A father, who is in a wheelchair, is reluctant to join his son in going fishing, until his son's love finally moves him to action.

Reading with Dad (2000) by Richard Jorgensen – A father and daughter share the power and joy of reading together from youth to old age.

The Summer My Father Was Ten (1998) by Pat Brisson – A father tells his son the story of how he damaged a neighbor's tomato garden when he was a boy and what he did to make amends.

Tight Times (1979) by Barbara Shook Haxen – A small boy, not allowed to have a dog because times are tight, finds a starving kitten in a trash can on the same day his father loses his job.

Uncle Willie and the Soup Kitchen (1997) by DyAnne DiSalvo-Ryan – A story about a young boy and his Uncle Willie as he gathers food to prepare in a soup kitchen in which he works.

Visiting Day (2002) by Jacqueline Woodson – A young girl and her grandmother visit the girl's father in prison.

The Wall (1990) by Even Bunting – A little boy and his father visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, DC to find the name of the boy's grandfather.

Your Dad Was Just Like You (1993) by Dolores Johnson – A little boy, who is not getting along well with his father, learns some interesting things from his grandfather.
